COSTIA

Costia is a parasite that attaches itself to the body and fins of koi and goldfish. In the warm water months, they can multiply very rapidly and cause a massive fish kill within several days if left untreated. Symptoms include massive and rapid die-off of fish, reddened fins, difficulty breathing, and excess mucus production, causing the fish to be covered in a whitish film.

Treatment for a costia infestation includes SALT up to 0.6% (6 pounds per 100 gallons), anti-parasitic medicated food, and QUICK CURE. Quick cure is dosed at the rate of 1 OUNCE per 500 GALLONS once a day for 3 CONSECUTIVE DAYS. Skip the 4th day, TREAT on the 5th DAY and on the 6th DAY perform a 25% WATER CHANGE.
